1-8 1st couple set twice to 2nd lady: those three circle once round
9-16 1st couple set twice to 2nd man: those three circle once round
17-24 1st couple dance down the center, dance back up the center, and cast to 2nd place (2s moving up)
24-32 Dance 4 changes of rights and lefts

Repeat whole dance from progressed position

ROW WELL YE MARINERS

1651

Longways for as many as will

2nd couple improper.
Side R- Side L
Take hands in lines: all slip Left
All slip back to Right
Partners back-to-back
All clap own hands together, partners clap right, all clap own hands together, partners clap left
All clap own hands together, cross own hands on chest, partners clap both hands.
All move right one place (men down, women up, crossing the set when reaching the ends) *Repeat whole dance from progressed position*

8 bars The first couple lead down the middle and back, and cast off into second place
8 bars The top two couples four changes of a circular hey *Repeat whole dance from progressed position*

THE BELLES OF NEWPORT 1790 32-bar duple-minor longways

1-8 1s & 2s dance a right hand star & left hand star.
9-16 1s dance down the middle, come back & cast off, 2s move up.
17-24 1s, with the couple BELOW circle left, circle right.
25-32 1s & 2s dance 4 changes of rights and lefts. *Repeat whole dance from progressed position*

DRESSED SHIP

1774 Longways Duple Minor

1st corners set towards each other, fall back; and turn each other.

2nd corners the same.

1st couple cast down, 2nd couple moving up on last 4 beats; all set to partners, and men turn their partners under their R arms.

1st couple cast up to places, 2nd couple moving down; all set to partners, 2nd couple cast up while 1st man turns his partner under his arm, moving down into 2nd place. *Repeat whole dance from progressed position*

SAYLOR'S REPRIEVE 1799 Longways Duple Minor

8 bars The first lady right hand turn the second man, then turn the second lady with the left hand
8 bars The first man right hand turn the second lady, then turn the second man with the left hand
8 bars First couple cross and cast into second place and turn 1.5 times
8 bars Both couples right hand star and then left hand star.

OFF SHE GOES 1805 Longways Duple Minor

- 8 bars First couple cast off two couples and back again

YOUNG WIDOW 1807 Longways Triple Minor Set

- 1-8 1s and 2s 4 hands across right and then back left
- 9-16 1s dance down the middle, turn as a couple halfway, lead back up and cast off on improper sides
- 17-24 Taking hands in lines of 3 on the sides, set twice and circle halfway around.
- 25-32 2s and 3s face up and down (1s falling back out of the way) and set twice; 2s & 3s two changes of rights and lefts.

8 bars Top two couples make a right-hand star once around, and back with the left hand 8 bars First couple join hands and slip down the middle and return to second place, seconds moving up; the first two couples pousette clockwise once around *Repeat entire dance from progressed position*

HULLS VICTORY 1812

Longways Duple Minor

A1. 1s, giving right hand to partner, cross over and give left hand to corner to form a wavy line of four; all balance forward and back; corners (dropping partner's hand) turn once around by left hands.

A2. 1s, giving right hand to partner, cross over and give left hand to neighbor to form a new wavy line of four; all balance forward and back; 1s (dropping partners hand) turn once around by the left hand.

B1. 1s dance down the middle (2s move up), turn, dance back up the middle and cast off.

B2. 1s and 2s dance 4 changes of Rights & Lefts, starting with partner.
